Inclusiv, the national CDFI intermediary and network of more than 500 community development credit unions (CDCUs) and cooperativas, invested \$2.5 million in social impact deposits to 10 Minority Depository Institution (MDI) credit unions—including Hawaii First FCU on Hawaii Island—to advance equitable recovery initiatives in underinvested communities severely impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.
