On September 26, Hurricane Helene hit northwest Florida Thursday and continued with widespread flooding, fatalities, and damages throughout Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, and South Carolina. At least 129 people have died because of the devastation Hurricane Helene has brought to Southeastern states, including dozens in flood-stricken North Carolina. According to the National Hurricane Center, Helene was a Category 4 storm with 140 mph sustained winds and higher gusts when it made landfall.

“It’s heartbreaking to see the devastation across so many communities in the wake of this storm, and it is incredibly impactful to see the credit union community’s people-helping-people mindset bringing so many together with a cooperative spirit to respond to this disaster,” said America’s Credit Unions President/CEO Jim Nussle.
