[NCUA Enhances Credit Union Locator and Research a Credit Union Applications](#)

NCUA released the latest versions of its [Credit Union Locator](#) and [Research a Credit Union](#) web applications today. These applications are now mobile responsive and have updated mapping technology and other new features and enhancements to improve their performance and accessibility.

The Credit Union Locator includes additional search options to help users find needed financial products and services, such as bilingual services, financial counseling, and wire transfer services. Other features include a new locate me function, which allows users to access a list of credit unions in their vicinity. Users can hover over a map to access a credit union's information and get directions to that credit union from their selected location.

Users can now easily toggle between Credit Union Locator, Research a Credit Union, and the Credit Union and Corporate Call Report Data Analysis webpage

Nomination of candidates for Director-at-large is now being accepted and will be conducted in accordance with Article IV Section 4(c) as follows:

The Board of Directors of a member credit union may nominate only one (1) of its credit union members. The nominee must be a member in good standing. The nominee's written consent must accompany the nomination form. In order to be valid, all nomination forms must be received by HCUL Engagement Manager no later than 4:30 p.m. on December 20. In the event December 20, is a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday, the nomination form must be received no later than 4:30 p.m. of the next League working day
